# *New Search for William Bawden Is Unavailing*

Carl J. Tobiussen, superintendent of the county farm, yesterday morning made a search of the country north and south of the Tahoe-Ukiah highway in an effort to find William Bawden, old resident of Grass Valley, who disappeared from the county hospital last Saturday morning.

It was Tobiussen's theory that the man is dead and that decomposition would have advanced to the stage that buzzards, those scavengers of the air, would be hovering over the spot where the body might be lying.

He reported that he saw none of the buzzards in his covering of the section.
